12 journalists are currently in jail in Turkey

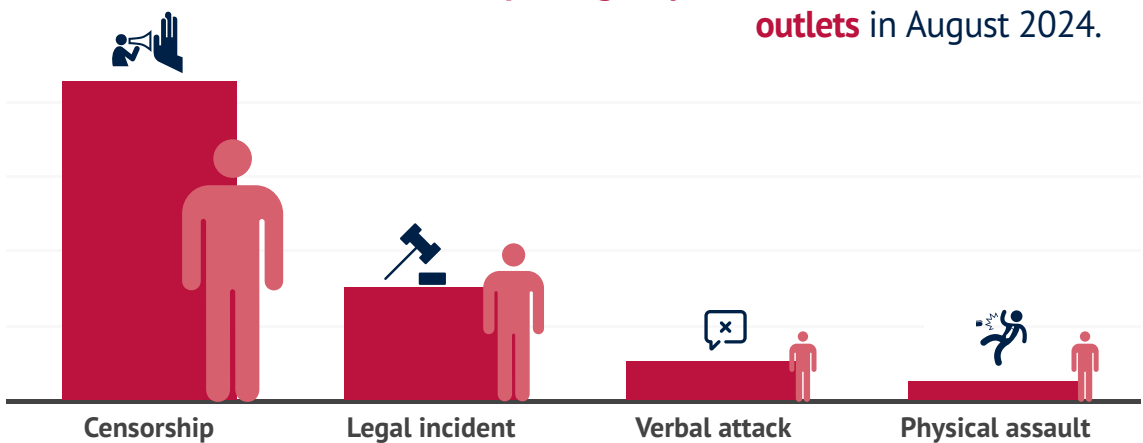
A local court **upheld** the **20-month prison sentence** handed to journalist **Bülent Mumay**.



Behind Bars

Top Violations

IPI documented **at least 26 alerts** impacting **17 journalists, media workers or outlets** in August 2024.



Press Freedom Newsroom

Instagram banned. Journalists sentenced to prison, censored and threatened.

1 journalist was sentenced to prison.
17 news articles were blocked.

A local court has **upheld the prison sentence** for journalist **Bülent Mumay** due to a social media post. [Read IPI's joint statement for details.](#)

Turkey **blocked access to Instagram** on Aug 2 for 8 days.

After releasing a new report, journalist Sinan Aygül was **subjected to threats and a physical assault.**

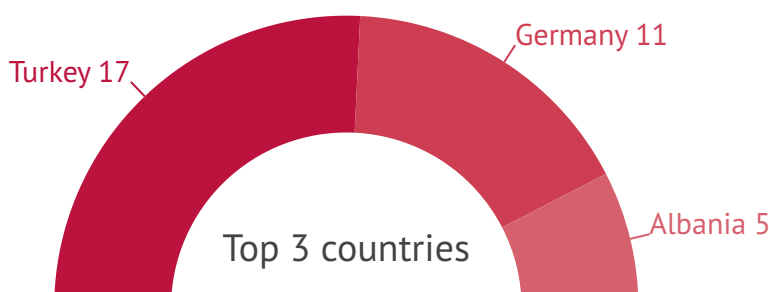
Journalist Barış Pehlivan is facing a **potential 9-year prison sentence** because of his news report.

A local court **blocked access** to Mezopotamya Agency's website **for the 36th time** since its establishment.
