Journalist Furkan Karabay was sentenced to prison and fined 12,500 TL with the charges of defamation and slander.


Behind Bars

Trial Monitoring

In June, at least 36 journalists stood trial. 19 of the hearings were adjourned. One journalist was sentenced to prison and fined, while 4 journalists were acquitted. In these trials, most journalists were charged with terrorism-related crimes.


